It started on February 23, 1957 with 24 members sponsored by the Gifu Rotary Club, and has produced three district governors and RI regulation deliberation members, and has won numerous awards. It has been more than 65 years, and now about 90 members are engaged in various activities such as vocational service, social service, international service, and youth service.

In recent years, especially in service projects, we value the connection with local people, support the Kano High School Interact Club and Gifu Shotoku Gakuen University Rotaract Club. We have established the Gifu Media Cosmos Hotaru Council, a stream of Teniteo of "Seseragi no Namiki". Through the firefly that inhabits the stream, we will work with the local residents to maintain and preserve the natural environment, create a place for local residents to relax and interact as a local culture, and eventually revitalize the city center of Gifu City. Kinkasan Supporters planned "What can be done by the power of the citizens" as a mountain of familiarity of the citizens about the conservation and utilization of Mt. Kinka, which is the symbol of Gifu. It was established and developed in 2003, and this year is the 17th year. As our club, we actively support activities, and as a local community, we participate in Jinhua Mountain conservation activities involving Rotaract as well as rotary clubs.

The idea is to spread the "ideal idea of service" to society through individual professions, not just to oneself or one's peers.
